## Examples:

Proverbs 31:11 says, "The heart of her husband doth safely trust in her, so that he shall have no need of spoil." A good summary word might be **trustworthy**.

Proverbs 31:27 says, "She looketh well to the ways of her household, and eateth not the bread of idleness." This verse could be summarized with the word **diligent**.

**3.** The chart on page 5 has been divided into 6 columns, one for each of the following headings: **Thoughts, Food, Clothing, Business, Speech, Outreach.** 

Go back through all the verses, noticing your red markings of action words. As you read through the verses, write down what the virtuous woman does in each of these areas. Also write the verse reference for each listing.
